## **Fusion Viewer version 3 release 4 End User License Agreement**

This EULA also applies to any updates, plug-ins, add-on components, patches and/or supplements that KGB Technologies may provide to you after you obtain the initial copy of the Software. By installing, operating, downloading, copying, or otherwise using the Software you agree to the terms of this EULA. If you do not agree to the terms of this EULA, do not install or use the Software.

### **Proprietary Rights**

Excepted as explicitly stated in this agreement, the Software is owned exclusively by KGB Technologies, and this license does not transfer any ownership of the Software to you. Fusion Viewer is protected by U.S. copyright and other intellectual property laws and by international treaties. KGB Technologies reserves to itself all rights not explicitly granted in this agreement. The Software is licensed, not sold.
